

Dear Shri Rakesh Mohan,

Kindly refer to my D.O. letter No.6-24/2008-Sch.6 dated 24.3.2009 & 8.6.2009 regarding strict compliance of provisions of section 4 & 6 of the Anti Tobacco Act so as to prevent use of tobacco by the students and teachers in schools.

2. It is necessary to enforce the law relating to the sale of tobacco products to ensure that young persons do not consume tobacco. **Section 6(b) of the cigarettes and other Tobacco Products (Prohibition of Advertisement and Regulation of Trade and commerce Production , Supply and Distribution) Act,2003 prescribes that no person shall sell or offer for sale or permit sale of cigarettes or other tobacco products within a radius of one hundred yards of any educational institution.** The Cigarettes and other Tobacco Products (Display of Board by Educational Institution) Rules 2009 have come into effect from 19.01.2010.

3. Ministry of Health & Family Welfare has again issued guidelines for **Tobacco Free Schools / Educational Institutions** A copy of the Guidelines along with the Gazette Notification is enclosed. I shall be thankful if necessary action is taken by the State /UT Governments to implement the above guidelines.

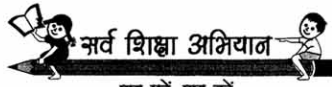

Guidelines for Tobacco-free Schools/ Educational Institutions

1. Display of "Tobacco free School" or "Tobacco-free Institution" board at a prominent place on the boundary wall outside the main entrance.
2. No sale of tobacco products inside the premises and Within the radius of 100 yards from school / educational institutions and mandatory signage in this regard shall be displayed prominently near the main gate and on boundary wall of school / institute.
3. No smoking or chewing of tobacco inside the premises of institution by students/ teachers/ other staff members / visitors.
4. Display of sign boards "No Smoking Area- Smoking here is an offence", of 60X30cm size inside the institution (as mandated by law).
5. Posters with information about the harm effects of tobacco shall be displayed at prominent places in the school/ institutions. Students shall be encouraged to make their own posters on tobacco control themes.
6. A copy of the Cigarette and other tobacco products Act (COTPA) 2003 shall be available with the principal/ head of school/ institution. (May be downloaded from the website of the Ministry of Health & Family Welfare- www.mohfw.nic.in)
7. A "Tobacco Control Committee" shall be in place. It may be chaired by school head/ principal, with members comprising of a science teacher, or any other teachers , school counselor (if available), at least two NSS/NCC/scout students, at least two

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parents representatives, area MLA, area SHO, Municipal Councilor, member of PRIs, any other member. The committee shall monitor the tobacco control initiatives of the school/institute. The committee shall meet quarterly and report to the district administration.

8. Integrate tobacco control activities with on going School Health Programme of the State
9. Promote writing of Anti- tobacco slogans on the School/ Institute stationery.
10. The principal / head of school / institute shall recognize tobacco control initiatives by students/ teachers/ other staff and certificates of appreciation or awards may be given.
11. State Nodal Officer for Tobacco Control in the State Health Directorate may be consulted for technical or any other inputs.

(ख) "शैक्षिक संस्थाओं" से कोई भी ऐसा स्थान/केन्द्र अभिप्रेत है जहाँ विशिष्ट मानदंडों के अनुसार शैक्षिक पढ़ाई कराई जाती है और इनमें एक उपयुक्त प्राधिकरण द्वारा स्थापित अथवा मान्यताप्राप्त कोई भी स्कूल, कालेज अथवा उच्चतर शिक्षण को संस्थाएं शामिल हैं;

(2) इसमें प्रयुक्त और इन नियमों में परिभाषित न किए गए अपितु अधिनियम में परिभाषित शब्दों और अभिव्यक्तिक का अर्थ उन्हें अधिनियम में क्रमशः दिया गया अर्थ होगा।

3. शैक्षिक संस्थाओं द्वारा बोर्ड का प्रदर्शन.—(1) शैक्षिक संस्था के कार्यकलापों का मालिक अथवा प्रबंधक अथवा प्रभारी कोई व्यक्ति परिसरों के बाहर मुख्य स्थान (स्थानों) पर एक बोर्ड प्रदर्शित करेगा जिस पर सुस्पष्ट रूप से यह लिखा होगा कि शैक्षिक संस्था के 100 गज के दायरे के भीतर आने वाले क्षेत्र पर सिगरेट और अन्य तम्बाकू उत्पादों की विक्री प्रतिबंधित है और यह धारा 24 के अंतर्गत जुमाने, जिसे बढ़ाकर दो सौ रुपये तक किया जा सकता है, के साथ एक दंडनीय अपराध है।

(2) उप-नियम (1) में संदर्भित 100 गज की दूरी को शैक्षिक संस्था की चार दीवारी बाड़ अथवा जैसा भी मामला हो, की बाहरी सीमा से क्रिय के आधार पर मापा जाएगा।

सा.का.नि. 40(अ).—सिगरेट और अन्य तम्बाकू उत्पाद (वितरण का प्रतिबंध और व्यापार तथा वाणिज्य, उत्पादन, आपूर्ति और वितरण का विनियमन) अधिनियम, 2003 (2003 का 34) की धारा 31 द्वारा प्रदत्त शक्तियों का प्रयोग करते हुए और शैक्षिक संस्थाओं के आस-पास सिगरेट और अन्य तम्बाकू उत्पादों पर प्रतिबंध नियमावली, 2004 के अधिकरण में इन बातों के सिवाय जिन्हें ऐसे अधिकरण से पूर्व किया गया है अथवा करने से लोप किया गया है, केन्द्र सरकार एतद्वारा निम्नलिखित नियम बनाती है; अर्थात्:—

1. संक्षिप्त नाम, विस्तार और प्रारम्भ.—(1) इन नियमों का नाम सिगरेट और अन्य तम्बाकू उत्पाद (शैक्षिक संस्थाओं द्वारा बोर्ड प्रदर्शित करना) नियमावली, 2009 है।

(2) ये पूरे भारत पर लागू होंगे।

(3) ये राजपत्र में उनके प्रकाशन की तारीख को प्रवृत्त होंगे।

2. परिभाषाएं.—(1) इन नियमों में जब तक कि संदर्भ में अन्यथा अपेक्षित न हो;—

NOTIFICATION

New Delhi, the 19th January, 2010

G.S.R. 40(E).—In exercise of the powers conferred by Section 31 of the Cigarettes and Other Tobacco Products (Prohibition of Advertisement and Regulation of Trade and Commerce, Production, Supply and Distribution) Act, 2003 (34 of 2003), and in supersession of the Prohibition on sale of the Cigarettes and Other Tobacco Products around Educational Institutions Rules, 2004, except as respects things, done or omitted to be done before such supersession, the Central Government hereby makes the following rules, namely:—

1. Short title, extent and commencement.—(1) These rules may be called the Cigarettes and Other Tobacco Products (Display of Board by Educational Institutions) Rules, 2009.

(2) They shall extend to the whole of India.

(3) They shall come into force on the date of their publication in the Official Gazette.

2. Definitions.—(1) In these rules, unless the context otherwise requires,—

(a) "Act" means the Cigarettes and Other Tobacco Products (Prohibition of Advertisement and

Regulation of Trade and Commerce, Production, Supply and Distribution) Act, 2003 (34 of 2003);

(b) "educational institution" means any place or centre where educational institutions are imparted according to the specific norms and include any school/college and institution of higher learning established or recognised by an appropriate authority;

(2) Words and expression used and not defined in these rules but defined in the Act shall have the meanings respectively assigned to them in the Act.

3. Display of Board by Educational Institutions.—

(1) The owner or manager or any person in charge of affairs of the educational institution shall display and exhibit a board at a conspicuous place outside the premises, prominently stating that sale of cigarettes and other tobacco products in an area within a radius of one hundred yards of educational institution is strictly prohibited and that it is an offence punishable under Section 24 of the Act with fine which may extend to two hundred rupees.

(2) The distance of one hundred yards referred to in sub-rule (1), shall be measured radially starting from the outer limit of the boundary wall or fence, as the case may be, of the educational institution.
