Sub: Guidelines of Examination and Promotion for Classes III to VIII For The Academic Session 2023-24

The Directorate of Education as per the Circular 5/212/Exam/16-17/Part-1/717-727 has brought out a new Assessment Plan for Classes III to VIII for the session 2023-24. The main points of the policy are as under:

- There shall be a regular qualifying examination in Class V & Class VIII.
- In order to be declared 'PASS' (Applicable for STD. V & VIII) at the end of the session for promotion to the next higher class, a student must secure at least 33% marks in each subject studied by him/ her during the session. The promotion to the next higher class is also subject to the condition that a minimum of 25% of marks must be scored in Mid Term Examination plus Annual Examination
- Assessment of classes III, IV, VI & VII will be done on the same examination
 pattern as of classes V & VIII and the students of classes III, IV, VI & VII will not be
 held back in the same class.
- Academic Session for classes III to VIII will have assessment as Periodic Tests (May & December), Mid Term Examinations (September) & Annual Examinations (March). *(Change in dates will be intimated to you.)
- Fraction of the marks will be rounded off as per mathematical formula in all the subjects and classes, for example: 8.1 to 8.4 will be rounded off to 8.0 and 8.5 to 8.9 rounded off to 9.0.
- Regular Assessment of a student of classes III to VIII will be done regularly throughout the academic session as per the weightage of marks given in the table:
